

ACCESSIBLE CHURCH

We aim to make our church welcoming and accessible to all. If you have a particular need or concern, please contact the church office.

Parking & Readibus

In the forecourt there are two designated spaces for Blue Badge holders and other spaces may be used if reasonable access to the church building is left open.

There is a designated space available in the back car park and one in the Warehouse car park.

Readibus will drop off and accompany in as necessary, there is a wheelchair available in the church if required.

Entering the church

At the front of the church, access is via a narrow ramp with a two inch step, or there is a wide ramp to the right of the church building. Please ask a steward to open the doors for you. (There are three sets of double doors to access the King's Room (Sanctuary) via the right hand entrance.)

Accessible Toilets

There is one accessible toilet adjacent to the King's Room via

the door to the left of the pulpit. There is a small ramp and a further door into a foyer where the toilet is situated.

There are two accessible toilets in the Warehouse, which can also be reached from the back of the King's Room, although there is a ramp between the church and the Warehouse and double doors to negotiate. Please ask a steward for assistance, they will be happy to help you.

Seating

Please ask a steward if you have particular seating needs, and they will try to accommodate you.

Sound and Vision

Large print handouts are available on request at the welcome desk.

Signage on internal doors is also in Braille.

Hearing loops are available in the King's Room and the sports hall in the Warehouse.

Assistance dogs are welcome.
